Streaming KartinaTV with DVBLink throughout the home network and to mobile devices on-the-go

DVBLink enables Live-TV, remote EPG and scheduling remote recordings for KartinaTV everywhere.

DVBlogic, the company enabling TV everywhere, today announced the availability of DVBLink for KartinaTV, a new source application integrating Russian and CIS based television channels from the IPTV provider KartinaTV GmbH into the Windows Media Center. A 20-day trial of the software is available on the DVBlogic website at <http://www.dvblogic.com>.

KartinaTV provides Russian TV and channels from other Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS) to Russian speaking users all over the world via the Internet. Subscribed users access more than 100 channels using a proprietary windows application or a KartinaTV set-top box.

With DVBLink for KartinaTV all native TV control features of Windows Media Center are available for KartinaTV channels as well, such as program live television, guide listings, time shifting, one touch and timer recordings as well as streaming to Windows Media extenders like XBox 360. If DVBLink Connect! Server is also installed, UPnP enabled network devices within the home network, PCs, laptops and mobile clients like Boxee, iPhone, iPad, Android and Windows phones can access Live TV and program guides or schedule recordings from everywhere. Users can also write their own clients using the DVBLink Remote API.

“KartinaTV is a great opportunity for Russian speaking people living everywhere to stay in touch with their homeland TV program,” explains Pavlo Barvinko, CTO at DVBlogic. “Usually watched in a proprietary PC application, DVBLink substantially improves the viewing experience for KartinaTV’s content. With DVBLink for KartinaTV and Connect! Server the user can access tv channels and manage his own recordings from wherever he likes.”
